Lifting the Resilience of Cellular Telecommunications Networks

Portfolio Media and Communications / Emergency Management and Recovery

On 24 June 2025, the Cabinet Expenditure and Regulatory Review Committee:

- noted that electricity outages are the single biggest cause of telecommunications outages in emergency events and that extending the duration of battery backup at cellular sites has proven itself an effective and cost-efficient method of lifting telecommunications resilience;
- 2 **noted** that \$6.400 million of 2024/25 funding for connectivity investment associated with the re-planning of the 600 MHz radio spectrum band is available to be reprioritised;
- agreed to reprioritise the above funding to lift the resilience of approximately 200 to 250 cellular telecommunications sites by increasing the length of time that cellular sites can operate off batteries to a minimum of 24 hours;
- 4 **agreed** to establish the following new appropriation:
