Government Response to the Petition of Malkiat Singh

Portfolio Immigration

On 31 July 2025, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- noted that on 22 May 2025, the Petitions Committee referred the *Petition of Malkiat Singh:* Remove the ballot system and limits from the Parent Resident visa to the Minister of Immigration for response;
- noted that the petition requests that "the House of Representatives urge the Government to remove the ballot system and the limit of 500 approvals per year from EOIs received after October 2022 for the Parent Resident visa to allow the family reunification of overseas-born New Zealanders and residence visa holders with their parents";
- **noted** that the proposed Government response acknowledges the concerns raised by the petitioner as they pertain to the Parent Category ballot system and outlines an upcoming review of the allocation system;
- 4 approved the Government response, attached at Annex One under LEG-25-SUB-0144;
- 5 **noted** that the Government response must be presented to the House by 18 August 2025;
- **noted** that, once approved, the Government response can be presented to the House on the next available working day;
- 7 **invited** the Minister of Immigration to present the Government response to the House in accordance with Standing Order 380.
