
Energy sector levies – sub-sector view

In total, the sector pays just over \$180 million in sector-specific levies. The following diagram illustrates the levy flows by subsector.


There are 7 sector-specific levies.

- The largest is the Electricity Industry
 Levy, collecting around \$110 million per
 annum, which is mostly used to fund the
 Electricity Authority.
- The Petrol or Engine Fuel Monitoring Levy is the second largest, at around \$50 million per annum, this is mostly applied to meeting New Zealand's International Energy Agency obligations (including purchase of IEA tickets).

A share of the levies are managed by the Commerce and Consumer, and Workplace Safety and Relations portfolios.
