Financial Service Providers (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2025

Portfolio Commerce and Consumer Affairs

On 11 September 2025, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- noted that in April 2025, the Cabinet Business Committee agreed to amend the Financial Service Providers (Fees) Regulations 2010 to reflect the actual cost of criminal history checks and align fee expressions with standard practice [CBC-25-MIN-0008];
- 2 **noted** that the Financial Service Providers (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2025 (the Regulations) will give effect to the decision referred to in paragraph 1 above;
- **authorised** the submission to the Executive Council of the Financial Service Providers (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2025 [PCO 28187/5.0];
- 4 **noted** that the Regulations will come into force on 16 October 2025.
