Releasing the Fuel Security Plan

Portfolio Associate Energy

On 15 October 2025, the Cabinet Economic Policy Committee:

- **noted** that establishing a Fuel Security Plan (the Plan) is a commitment in the National-New Zealand First Coalition Agreement;
- 2 **noted** that feedback from public consultation on a draft version of the Plan was broadly supportive and that the Associate Minister for Energy has made minor changes to the Plan based on this feedback;
- **noted** that the vision of the Plan is to have a fuel system that is resilient to disruptions, so that people have access to fuel where and when they need it;
- 4 **noted** that the objective of the Plan is to maintain fuel supply by improving energy independence, reducing vulnerabilities in New Zealand's fuel supply chains and minimising the impacts of fuel disruptions;
- agreed that the Plan, attached under ECO-25-SUB-0163, be finalised and published;
- authorised the Associate Minister for Energy to approve any minor changes to the Plan prior to public release.
