Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Erica Stanford – April 2026

Portfolio **Immigration**

On 30 March 2026, Cabinet:

- 1 **authorised** the absence of Hon Erica Stanford from New Zealand, from 19 to 22 April 2026, to travel to Singapore to promote the Active Investor Plus (AIP) visa;
- 2 **agreed** that she be accompanied by one member of staff;
- 3 **approved** the estimated expenditure of up to \$28,395.05 for the travel expenses of the Ministerial party as a charge to Vote Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive – Travel);
- 4 **agreed** that in her absence:
 - 4.1 Hon David Seymour act as Minister of Education;
 - 4.2 Hon Chris Penk act as Minister of Immigration;
 - 4.3 Hon Louise Upston act as Lead Coordination Minister for the Government's Response to the Royal Commission's Report into Historical Abuse in State Care and in the Care of Faith-based Institutions;
- 5 **noted** that leave from Parliament has been approved.
