1. Provincial Growth Fund Proposals

Wairoa

Comment:

The Provincial Development Unit (PDU) continues to support organisations in Wairoa to develop proposals to be considered for Provincial Growth funding. Development of future proposals will benefit from the \$250,000 capability funding awarded to the Wairoa District Council, which was announced earlier this month.

On Wednesday 22 August, John Sproat (Independent Advisory Panel member) and the PDU Regional Advisor joined the Mayor to visit local timber mills, food producers, and rope makers. PDU management received positive feedback about the visit which has been provided to your office.

We will continue to support the region and update you on progress.

Manawatū-Whanganui

Comment:

The PDU is working with organisations in the region to progress applications ahead of potential announcements to be made in November. At this stage the announcement is likely to be tourism and infrastructure focused.

Staff from the PDU will visit the region on 5 September to talk about the region's water scheme. We will advise you and your office of any outcomes from this visit.

Tairāwhiti

Comment:

Progress is being made to prepare for the announcement of the Tairāwhiti investment package on Friday 7 September 2018. The package will be in excess of \$\frac{commercial Information}{2}\$ and include a significant investment for roading resilience (up to \$\frac{commercial Information}{2}\$, including up to \$137 million from the PGF). The focus on roading reflects the underinvestment in roading infrastructure in Tairāwhiti and the importance of adequate roading to increase productivity in the region.

Other components of the package include investments in tourism infrastructure and product development, and primary industries. The investment package is focused on improving regional productivity and employment. The PDU will work with the region to implement initiatives to ensure employment opportunities are maximised.

2. Provincial Development Unit

PipeDrive Update

Comment:

As at 20 August 2018, 440 projects have been lodged in PipeDrive, 13 of these are new this week. Of the 440 projects, 214 are EoI and 225 are applications. Of the 225 applications, 100 have had funding committed.

Update on the focus for the PGF July – December 2018

Comment:

In July, the PDU outlined our approach to support the successful delivery of the PGF. This focused on four key areas:

- Speed up processing to provide certainty to applicants
- 2. Targeted engagement for regions and sectors
- 3. Value over volume
- 4. Integrated investment packages for the regions.

We have made substantial progress on these key areas since July:

- Updated application forms have been adopted to simplify the process for applicants and improve the quality of applications received by the PDU. This includes the introduction of an accelerated process for low-value applications (Under \$100,000).
- Cabinet agreed in July to changes to support the implementation of the PGF. This included delegating decision-making to the Head of the PDU to decline applications that do not meet PGF criteria. This has resulted in efficiencies from an assessment and decision-making perspective.
- A new Senior Regional Official (SRO) operating model has been implemented that reflects the needs of each region and supports greater coordination across government and within the regions. All regions (with the exception of Top of the South/Te Tau Ihu) now have a dedicated SRO. An induction to the PGF has been held for the SROs and their first meeting to review investment proposals will be held on 30 August 2018.
- On 2 August, we successfully launched the Investment Statement and Guide to the PGF. At the same time, the revised PGF website was also launched. Since the launch on 2 August, there have been 25,000 visits to the PGF website
- The PDU's operating model has been finalised and departmental funding for PGF agencies has been approved by Ministers.
- Engagement in the regions and across key sectors has commenced to promote the PGF and support the development of quality applications. The PDU has been involved in Tourism events, banking and regional forums.

Next Steps:

The focus for the PDU along with PGF agencies is to develop integrated investment packages for the regions, with packages for Tairāwhiti and West Coast shortly to be finalised. The packages consist of workforce, sector and infrastructure components.





The Waikato Regional Economic Summit

Comment:

The Waikato Regional Economic Summit will be held on 30-31 August 2018 in Hamilton, Waikato.

The Summit will identify the priority areas of economic growth throughout the Waikato region, and will be attended by approximately 300 people from central and local government, lwi, and industry.

Minister Jackson, Minister Jones, Minister Mahuta, and Under-Secretary Fletcher Tabuteau have confirmed that they will attend. Minister Sepuloni may be attending. Minister Jones and the Under-Secretary will be speaking at the event.

Officials will provide a background event briefing to all Ministers, and the Under-Secretary. Talking points and key internation will be provided for Minister Jones, and a full speech will be drafted for the Under-Secretary.

Visit to the Eastern Bay of Plenty

Comment:

On 21 August Minister Robertson, Minister Twyford, Minister Jackson and Under-Secretary Tabuteau visited the Eastern Bay of Plenty to meet with the Regional Growth Leadership Group. Minister Mahuta visited the Group on 22 August.

A range of matters were discussed:

- Core infrastructure projects (waste water projects)
- Estimated jobs by each infrastructure project
- Potential 'phasing' options, to accelerate job creation
- Possibility of focusing on four key sectors initially to achieve regional realignment of jobs and GDP to the national average
- Infrastructure management capability and funding
- Aligning social services and training establishments to four core sectors
- An employment strategy to support the region to ensure workforce requirements are met to deliver on projects

The meetings were highly constructive, establishing strong relationships and a platform to move forward in a coordinated manner.

It was acknowledged the three way partnership (Opotiki, Whakatane and Kawerau) was a successful structure for progressing regional development in the Eastern Bay of Plenty.

Road Freight Transport

3. Sector Workforce Engagement Programme (SWEP)

- Minister Jackson met with the industry reference group to discuss long standing labour market issues and the strategies being implemented to address these.
- Minister Jackson visited the Road Safety Truck that was parked in parliament grounds last week. The truck is currently used to travel the country delivering road safety messages around trucks. There are preliminary plans to expand this to a careers truck for the transport industry.
- SWEP was involved in the planning, set up and running of the Transport Careers Expo in Tauranga over two days. A number of school students, jobseekers and those wanting a career change came through and interest was shown in the industry cadetship.
- Announcement of a new level 3 Commercial Road Transport
 Programme at Ara in Timaru. SWEP has been on the
 working group for this programme and the region has created
 a strong industry led model which will pilot a group
 employment scheme.
- Recruitment has started for a Transport Careers Coordinator in Tairāwhiti. The main funder is the Ministry of Social Development with SWEP also contributing. The Coordinator will be employed by the Eastland Wood Council and aligns with the Generation Wood programme that is funded by He Poutama Rangatahi.












Applications by region – 20 August 2018
