1. Provincial Growth Fund Proposals

Waikato

Comment:

The Waikato Economic Summit was held on 30 and 31 August 2018, with Ministers Jones, Mahuta and Jackson and Under-Secretary Tabuteau in attendance on the first day. Over 250 regional stakeholders from business, iwi, local and central government, community groups and philanthropic organisations came together to agree on the Waikato region's economic priorities and the potential projects which Te Waka, the new regional economic development agency, will take forward over the next 12-24 months.

By the end of the Summit, a number of regional priorities emerged, including 'activating the Waikato river' through various tourism initiatives, developing the added value food industry across the region, and improving infrastructure to support economic opportunities (e.g. development of wharf infrastructure to support the growth of the aquaculture industry).

Over the coming weeks, Te Waka will consider the feedback and outputs from the Summit and develop a regional economic action plan. The action plan will identify projects which the region will be seeking Provincial Growth Fund (PGF) support.

Officials will work with the region to finalise the action plan and identify where government support can help progress proposals identified in the action plan.

West Coast

A West Coast Package for 29 November

The Provincial Development Unit (PDU) are working on a package of West Coast initiatives due to be announced on 29 November 2018 during a visit to the region by the Prime Minister, the Deputy Prime Minister and the Minister for Regional Economic Development.

At this stage the package will consistent of tourism initiatives, infrastructure projects and investment to support regional priorities.

PGF status update

Comment:

As at 3 September 2018, 484 projects had been lodged in PipeDrive. 25 are new projects as of this week. Of the 484 projects, 229 are Expression of Interest, 253 are applications and two are enquiries. Of the 253 applications, 137 projects have had funding approved. As of 3 September 2018, \$277 million of funding has been approved.

Construction Skills Strategy Action plan

Comment:

Next week a suite of Cabinet papers on the Construction Skill Strategy Action Plan will be considered by Ministers. Ministers requested advice around expanding Jobs and Skills Hubs in Auckland and elsewhere to support the construction workforce requirements.

The Minister of Employment will be recommending expanding Jobs and Skills Hubs into Northcote and also West Auckland. Officials will provide you with advice on how the Hub models could be adapted to support the regions through the PGF.

4. Māori Economic Development

2018 He Tupu Öhanga: Commercial Advisors Scheme

Comment:

The 2018 round of the He Tupu Ohanga: Commercial Advisors Scheme (CAS) will open for applications on 28 September 2018.

This year we introduced the Māori name He Tupu Ōhanga to preface the CAS, which signals that the essence of the scheme is about economic growth of collective Māori assets. The CAS funds collectives up to \$60,000 to work alongside commercial advisors to undertake projects that realise the full potential of their assets.

This will be the fourth CAS round and a \$1 million appropriation will be available for allocation to successful projects. Since 2015, the CAS has allocated \$8 million to fund 149 commercial projects of which 77 are still underway.



Progress of applications – 3 September 2018










Funding by region – 2 September 2018










Applications by region – 3 September 2018










Applications by sector – 3 September 2018
