Kia ora Alastair,

I've spoken with Amelia and Jason, and here's our briefing for the Minister of Finance on the 8 February MBIE report seeking the Minister of Finance's agreement to \$4.6m for the Manea Footprints of Kuph Centre.

We recommend the Minister of Finance does not agree to this proposal to approve funding. We will work with MBIE to support them to develop a new briefing that makes funding conditional on contactual milestones to give assurance on the management of the project.

Following MBIE's briefing being sent last week, the Minister of Finance verbally agreed on Monday 12 February to the project, making funding conditional on milestones. MBIE was directed to work with the Treasury on these. This briefing, dated 8 February, does not provide those conditions of tending.

Hi Alastair,

This was one of the projects agreed on Monday – but this particular one was subject to the Treasury and MBIE agreeing to commercial and management milestones as a condition of agreement.

I have not seen this briefing from MBIE so I'm not sure if those caveats are included in the briefing. If the caveats are, we support (as a second-best, given our concerns about the management, commercial and economic cases) MoF signing the report.

Amelia and Jason in our team (CC'd) are working with MBIE on developing those conditions of agreement.

Under the delegations agreed by Cabinet in December and at DEV yesterday, this is expected to be an ongoing approval requirement for any funding over \$1m.
