## 2. Regional Updates

#### 2.1 Hawkes Bay

#### **PipeDrive update**

As at 25 October, 56 Hawkes Bay applications and expressions of interest (EOIs) have been lodged in PipeDrive. The status of those applications/EOIs is:

- 17 applications are undergoing assessment
- 13 applications have been approved
- 18 expressions of interest are undergoing assessment.
- 8 applications have been declined.

#### **Regional Activity**

The region is close to submitting some exciting applications These include:

- a step-change in the apple and pear industry involving the establishment of new growing areas to satisfy international demand
- supporting the expansion of a Wairoa-based limery which grows and exports limes
- the development of an industrial based food cluster where local and external businesses can co-exist for mutual gain and lower costs.

All of the above proposals involve expanding existing enterprises and have potential to create new jobs, and in most cases bring new businesses to the region.

The Provincial Development Unit (PDU) is focusing on the development of a package for announcements in the first quarter of 2019. Its themes are:

- Training and Employment
- Food and Beverage
- Tourism
- Infrastructure
- Digital Connectivity.

#### PipeDrive update

As at 25 October, 23 applications from Canterbury have been lodged in PipeDrive. The status of those applications is:

# **Commercial Information**

#### **Opuke** Pools

Since 2009, Methven Adventures Ltd (MAL) has been developing a \$15 million project, the Opuke Thermal Pools and Spa Project. MAL is requesting financial support from the PGF which will facilitate project development and assist with securing sufficient third party capital.

PGF support is requested for two components:

- \$2 million grant (invested on an 80/20 basis with private capital)
- \$5.5 million concessionary loan (seven year low-interest loan, repayable early based on Opuke performance).

This will be brought to Ministers for approval in the next Regional Economic Development (RED) briefing.

If PGF funding is secured and the remainder of capital raised, Opuke should be operational by 2020.

#### 2.3 Northland

#### **PipeDrive update**

As at 25 October, 108 Northland applications and expressions of Interest (EOIs) are in PipeDrive. The status of those applications/EOIs is:

- 25 applications are undergoing assessment
- 16 expressions of interest are undergoing assessment.
- 5 applications are awaiting decisions.
- 11 applications are awaiting feedback from the applicant or other agencies.
- 29 applications have been approved
- 22 proposals have been declined/unsupported.

#### **Regional Activity**

The region has been undertaking some good work in prioritising the many proposals received in the training and employment (totalling \$38 million) and tourism (totalling \$81 million) sectors. This has helped the PDU to prioritise the assessment of key projects in order to obtain decisions for the upcoming Northland package (see below).

There are a number of projects in the assessment pipeline:

- Two proposals were considered at the Senior Regional Officials (SRO) meeting on 25 October - Ngawha Innovation and Enterprise Park and Camera Obscura. Ngawha Innovation and Enterprise Park was approved.
- A Northland soft berry proposal is currently being assessed by the MPI and PDU.
- An express application from Te Hiku requesting resource for a Project Manager to bring three projects to investment ready is currently under evaluation by MPI and the PDU.

There are currently two water proposals under consideration in Northland, one in relation to Kaipara and the Mid-North and another for Te Hiku.

#### Vocoming Announcements

The PDU is focusing on the development of a package for announcement in early 2019. The package is likely to include projects and programmes in the following areas:

- Training and Employment
- Tourism
- Primary sector
- Manufacturing/Innovation
- Infrastructure and Digital Connectivity.

#### 3.1 Select Committee Update

The PDU reported to the Economic Development Science and Innovation Committee (the Committee) on the PGF on 25 October 2018.

The Committee asked a broad range of questions including about transparency of funding agreements, funding for the South Island, the SRO model and examples of investments to date by Tier.

The Unit is expecting follow-up questions related to funding that has been dispersed to date.

#### 3.2 Economic Development NZ (EDNZ) Conferences

PDU staff attended this year's EDNZ conference. The theme for 2018 was 'Inclusive Growth' and presentations can be found here: <u>https://economicdevelopment.org.nz/speakers</u>

MBIE sponsored the conference, as per previous years - and PGF information, branded signage and collateral were available and on display throughout the two-day conference.

Awareness of the PGF was very high. Many conference attendees were interested in the PGF, with questions and comments covering a wide range of topics - from broad process questions to specific project related ones. It was clear that some people had been frustrated with the process to date, and the length of time some proposals had been in the system; however most people also understood and accepted the challenging task involved in establishing the PDU and PGF processes.

A key theme from one-on-one discussions, conference speakers and at least one award winner, was how regional organisations (not 'Wellington') knew their region best, and that regions should have more say in where the funding is directed. This is not a new theme at EDNZ conferences.
