



Protesters surrounded an Australian company's gold exploration drilling site in Northland, New Zealand.

About 200 people knocked down the partiers and went onto Evolution Mining's drilling site on the slopes of Puhipuhi mountain north of Whangarer on Sunday.

"Evolution Mining has been telling their Australian investors they have the support of the local hapu and community. But look at this crowd from the whole of the region - it sets that record straight," says MineWatch Northland spokesman Tim Howard.

"Evolution Mining has no social licence to be here. They are not wanted here in any shape or form."

Marchers raised the Ngatchau, United Types and Maori flags on drilling equipment, along with banners and placards.

Environmental campaigner Hori Chapman said mining was the opposite of what was needed for a prosperity in the region.

"Our focus is on healing the land; not poisoning it and our waterways with toxic mining waste. Heal the land and we'll heal the people."

There was also a protest at the drilling site in June.

Evolution acquired the Puhipuhi exploration permit in June 2015.

The company is in the early stages of an exploration program to find out whether there are gold and silver deposits at Puhipuhi that can be mined by underground methods.

"We are committed to engaging with tangata whenua, the community and key stakeholders throughout all stages of the exploration process," the company says on its website.

The company says it's uncertain if any deposits exist and establishing a mine at Puhipuhi is years away and may not occur at all.



Community meetings to reveal more of work on potential earthquake and tsunami threats on East Coast.

A GROUP of top scientists will today start hosting a series of community meetings to reveal more about the work they have in store to help better understand the potential earthquake and tsunami threats posed to East Coast residents by New Zealand's largest fault line.

Scientists from GNS Science, Niwa and Massey University will run a series of community meetings in Muriwai, Gisborne, Tolaga Bay and Ruatoria to provide details about upcoming research projects into the Hikurangi subduction zone, which is at one point just 40km off the Gisborne coast.

- Gisborne Waikanae Surf Life Saving Club, 5.30-7.30pm, Wednesday, June21
- Tolaga Bay Fire Station, noon to 2pm, Thursday, June 22
- Kariaka Pa, Ruatoria, 5-7pm, Thursday, June 22.

GNS Science geophysicist Laura Wallace said the meetings would give residents an overview of all the science that would be happening over the next couple of years, focused on the Hikurangi subduction zone.

"Obviously we will be talking about the International Ocean Discovery programme drilling, because that is a big part of the activity and seismic surveys."

Dr Wallace said there would be question and answer sessions at each meeting, so people could ask questions about different aspects of the programmes.

"We really want to use it as an opportunity to raise people's awareness about what is happening on the subduction plate boundary off the east coast and what we are trying to do to better understand it."

Unrelated to fracking

The meeting would help to reinforce the message that the planned work was unrelated to fracking and had "absolutely nothing" to do with oil exploration.

"We have to completely avoid any potential for petroleum or gas that could pose a danger to the ship. We won't be getting anywhere near stuff like that."

The first stage of drilling would begin in November, with instruments due to be put in place permanently in March next year.

"That's when we will install observatories within the bore holes to observe changes in the earth's crust."

Once observatories were installed, equipment would be able to monitor any changes during slow-slip events, which act like earthquakes but only happen over an extended period of time. They would provide data in the lead-up to an earthquake.

"Those will be in place for potentially a decade or more."

Implications for East Coast

Recent findings from a similar observatory, installed as part of the IODP project off the coast of Japan, presented important implications for the East Coast, Dr Wallace said.

"What they found in Japan, which was totally unexpected, was the instruments inside the bore holes saw evidence of episodic slow-slip events."

Though the Japanese events were smaller than the ones off the Gisborne coast, it opened up the possibility that the Gisborne project would see much smaller slow-slip events and other types of plate behaviours than had been possible previously.

"It really might open a whole new view of what is happening in the plate boundary offshore from Gisborne. So it's really exciting. We will really get a whole new view of what is happening out there."

The Hikurangi subduction zone, where the Pacific plate subducts or dives under the Australian plate along the east coast of the North Island, is just one of a number of locations worldwide notable for slow-slip events.

The Hikurangi meetings are supported by GNS Science, Niwa, Massey University, He Oranga Trust, Tamanuhiri Tutu Poroporo Trust, Gisborne District Council and East Coast LAB.

The \$6.5 million Hikurangi Subduction Earthquakes and Slip Behaviour research programme is funded by the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE), and will help New Zealand scientists take part in several international projects studying the Hikurangi subduction zone over the next five years.


