## **Ultra-Fast Broadband** (UFB)

There are 714,258 users connected to UFB, a 6.8% increase in connected users since end of September 2018.

### Uptake is 50%.

UFB will be available to 87% of New Zealanders, in about 390 towns and cities by the end of 2022.

The UFB build is currently 77% complete and is 4% ahead of schedule. Over 1.43 million end users can connect to UFB.

### **Rural Broadband** Initiative (RBI) Phase 2, and the Mobile Black Spot Fund

Over 70,000 rural households and businesses will receive new or improved broadband.

About 1,000 km of State Highway and over 100 tourism locations will receive new mobile coverage.

Three new sites providing mobile black spot coverage have been commissioned.

32,864 households and businesses can access improved broadband.

## 🔇 RBI Phase 1

Deployment is complete. 154 new towers have been built and 387 existing towers have been upgraded.

Over 110,000 copper lines have been upgraded.

304,574 users are able to connect. 123,634 users are connected.

RBI uptake is 40.6%.

Fibre-to-the-premises will be available to 87% of New Zealanders by the end of 2022.


UFB can deliver speeds close to 1,000 Megabits per second at present, depending on a user's chosen retail offering.


