## Electricity Price Review: Publication of Options Paper

## Portfolio

Energy and Resources

On 13 February 2019, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee (DEV):

1 noted that the Electricity Price Review Panel (the Panel) was appointed in April 2018 to investigate whether the electricity sector, as it exists at present, is delivering a fair price to consumers, and whether the electricity market and the regulatory framework will continue to be appropriate in the future, and particularly with the emergence of new technologies [ENV-18-MIN-0004 and APH-18-MIN-0039];

2 noted that on 5 September 2018, DEV noted the findings of the Panel's first report [DEV-18-MIN-0183];

3 noted the contents of the Panel's options paper, attached to the submission under DEV-19-DEV-0013 (the options paper), which includes a number of options developed by the Panel for addressing the need for electricity prices to be fair and affordable, not just efficient or competitive;
noted that the options:
4.1 are broad and address all aspects of the electricity sector;
4.2 are designed to act as a package and often work in tandem with each other;
4.3 range from being relatively mild to much more interventionist;

5 authorised the Minister of Energy and Resources to release the options paper once final formatting has been completed, in late February 2019.
