# 2018/19 Refugee Quota Programme: Reallocation of 150 Places Not Required by Australia

**Immigration** 

On 20 February 2019, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee:

- noted that in June 2013, the previous government agreed that:
  - 1.1 New Zealand would annually resettle up to 150 refugees who were subject to Australian offshore processing legislation within New Zealand's Refugee Quota Programme;
  - 1.2 if the 150 places were not required by Australia, the places would be reallocated to refugees referred by the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), subject to Cabinet consideration of regional allocations;

- 2 **noted** that Australian officials have advised that Australia does not require the annual 150 refugee quota places within the 2018/19 refugee quota;
- 3 agreed that:
  - 3.1 75 of the 150 refugee quota places not required by Australia in 2018/19 be reallocated to UNHCR-referred refugees from the Asia-Pacific region;
  - 3.2 75 be reallocated to UNHCR-referred Syrian refugees from the Middle East region.
