2. Regional Updates

2.1 Canterbury

PipeDrive update

As of 14 March 2019, 41 applications and EOI have been lodged in PipeDrive. The status of those applications is:

- 5 are being assessed
- 11 have been approved
- 11 have been declined, withdrawn or are unsupported
- 2 are awaiting further information
- 4 are on hold
- 8 are awaiting assessment.

Regional Activity

Two applications were on the agenda for the 28 February Senior Regional Officials (SROs) meeting. SROs approved a Provincial Growth Fund (PGF) grant of \$94,250 towards the cost of preparing a detailed business case for a second Ashburton Urban Bridge. The project is supported by the New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA) and is a top regional roading priority due to economic and population growth in the Ashburton district. The applicant has been informed. The other application was withdrawn before the meeting.

The Kaikoura District Council's feasibility study, funded by the PGF, for revitialising the town is progressing well with a focus is on the harbour, a marine centre of excellence and marina.

Porters Ski Field Limited, with a grant of \$250,000 from the PGF, is developing its summer mountain bike park offering. Since obtaining the grant, the project has been through its consenting stage and the company has converted two employees rom part-time to full-time. Trail construction will begin later this year and additional permanent and part-time positions will be created.

Mackenzie Basin Drylands Heritage area:

The Provincial Development Unit (PDU) has had initial discussions with the Mackenzie Country Trust on its plans to establish New Zealand's first Drylands Heritage Area. The area would protect the natural, cultural, pastoral, recreational and electricity generation heritage values in the Mackenzie Basin. Working closely with the Department of Conservation (DOC), the Trust might seek up to Confidential of government funding for community engagement and up to Confidential Information

over three years from the PGF to establish the Drylands Heritage Area.

Upcoming Announcements

The funding for the second Ashburton Urban Bridge is ready to be announced as soon as the funding agreement is signed. Three other funding agreements are nearing finalisation and these can then be planned for announcement.

2.2 Hawkes Bay

PipeDrive update

As of 14 March 2019, 100 applications and EOI have been lodged in PipeDrive. The status of those applications is:

- 20 are being assessed
- 19 have been approved
- 18 have been declined, withdrawn or are unsupported
- 3 are awaiting further information
- 13 are on hold
- 27 are waiting assessment.

Regional Activity

Napier City Council (NCC) has ^{Confi} PGF applications currently being assessed. The Mayor and CEO of NCC visited PDU officials in Wellington last week to discuss these applications.

Regional PDU staff supported the Under-Secretary's visit to Central Hawke's Bay District Council (CHBDC) on 22 February 2019 to meet with local small business owners as well as existing and potential PGF applicants.

PDU staff met with Wairoa District Council (WDC) to review findings and determine next steps regarding their PGF-funded Economic Opportunities Report.

Following discussions with Ministers, the PDU are re-evaluating current transport and water proposals and projects in the Hawke's Bay and will come back with options for consideration.

A Whenua Māori application from northern Hawke's Bay has been evaluated and will be considered by the Independent Advisory Panel (IAP) on 14 March 2019.

Regional RDU staff continue to engage with a broad range of organisations interested in PGF support. There are a number of applications from local iwi groups being progressed in a diverse range of areas such as One Billion Trees, land improvement and skills and training programmes.

A package announcement is imminent and will comprise regional investments, sector priorities, infrastructure, skills and training.

Regional Activity

Development West Coast held an Economic Development workshop on 13 February attended by Regional Leaders and Councillors from Grey District Council, Buller District Council, Westland District Council and West Coast Regional Council. The Chairman of Ngāti Waewae and the Operations Director for the West Coast, Department of Conservation also attended. Penny Bicknell, Principal Regional Advisor, PDU attended the meeting and presented to the group on the Provincial Growth Fund (PGF).

The objective of the meeting was to update the attendees on progress since the last meeting held in June 2018. The workshop was well received by the regional leaders.

The PDU held a second 'Team Government' workshop in the region on 13 March 2019 to be attended by representatives of the DOC, Te Puni Kokiri (TPK), Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI), NZTA, Department of Internal Affairs (DIA) and Ministry for Social Development (MSD). The cross-agency group will review the work programme for the next six months to ensure we are all working together to achieve the best outcomes for stakeholders in the region.

3.1 Matai Labs announcement

In November 2018 Regional Economic Development (RED) Ministers approved \$6 million for Matai Lab's to establish a Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) lab in Gisborne. We are engaging with the applicant to finalise a funding agreement and are looking to confirm a possible announcement date, with the view to compiling a programme of engagements for the Minister of Regional Economic Development.

Given the nature of the project, it may be worthwhile to engage the Minister of Research, Science and Innovation and the Minister of Health to make a joint announcement alongside the Minister of Regional Economic Development.

This is a particularly newsworthy story and we are awaiting an indication of the Minister's availability to visit Gisborne/ Tairāwhiti for announcement logistics.
