Enhancing the Conformance System

Portfolio Commerce and Consumer Affairs

On 1 May 2019, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee (DEV);

- 1 **noted** that the conformance system (the system) supports commerce and protects communities by providing assessments that give independent assurances about the quality of goods, services, systems and personnel;
- 2 **noted** that a recent Conformance Policy and Infrastructure Review, which was undertaken in consultation with relevant businesses, organisations and agencies, found that the system is sound overall but identified a set of actions to enhance the system and mitigate risks to commerce and community protection;
- 3 **agreed** to the Conformance System Strategy (the Strategy), as outlined in the paper under DEV-19-SUB-0092, as the vehicle for communicating and coordinating action to enhance the system;
- 4 **agreed** that the Strategy target four priority focus areas, based on the main challenges and opportunities in conformance:
 - organisational performance and governance;
 - 4.2 regulatory quality and practice;
 - 4.3 partnerships for skills and value;
 - 4.4 international trade connections;
- 5 **authorised** the Minister of Commerce and Consumer Affairs to approve any editorial changes to the Strategy, prior to its publication, to improve readability and accessibility for the public;
- 6 **invited** the Minister of Commerce and Consumer Affairs to evaluate the Strategy and report back to DEV at its conclusion after three years.
