## Minute of Decision

### New Zealand Business Number Funding (Validation and Authorisation) Bill: Approval for Introduction

Portfolio Small Business / Commerce and Consumer Affairs

On 13 May 2019, the Cabinet Business Committee:

- 1 **noted** that the New Zealand Business Number Funding (Validation and Authorisation) Bill (the Bill) holds a category 2 priority on the 2019 Legislation Programme (must be passed in the year);
- 2 **noted** that the Bill will:
  - 2.1 amend the Companies Act 1993 and the Companies Act 1993 Regulations 1994 to provide that fees collected under that Act may be used to fund New Zealand Business Number registry services and related functions;
  - 2.2 amend the New Zealand Business Number Act 2016 to insert a regulation-making power to enable all or some entities which have been allocated a New Zealand Business Number to be charged fees and levies for New Zealand Business Number registry services and related functions;
    - retrospectively validate the imposition, collection and use, for New Zealand Business Number registry purposes, of fees prescribed and collected under the Companies Act 1993;
- 3 **noted** that on 3 April 2019, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee (DEV) authorised the Minister for Small Business and the Minister of Commerce and Consumer Affairs to jointly make decisions on any minor or technical matters that may arise during the drafting of the Bill [DEV-19-MIN-0065];
- 4 **noted** that the Minister for Small Business and the Minister of Commerce and Consumer Affairs have jointly decided to insert a provision in the Bill repealing the ability for fees collected under the Companies Act 1993 to be used to fund New Zealand Business Number registry services and related functions four years after that Bill comes into force;
- 5 **approved** the New Zealand Business Number Funding (Validation and Authorisation) Bill [PCO 22028/3.0] for introduction, subject to the final approval of the government caucuses; and sufficient support in the House of Representative;

6 **agreed** that the Bill be introduced on 30 May 2019 (Budget night) and passed through all stages under urgency.
