On 7 May 2019, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- noted that in October 2018, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee agreed to amend the National Standards Regulations 1976 to update and modernise them [DEV-18-MIN-0236];
- 2 **noted** that the Measurement Standards Regulations 2019 give effect to the decisions referred to above;
- authorised the subrassion to the Executive Council of the Measurement Standards Regulations 2019 [PCO 22005/4.0];
- 4 **noted** that a waiver of the 28-day rule is sought:
 - 4.1 (so that the Regulations can come into force on 20 May 2019;
 - on the grounds that early commencement of the regulations is necessary for compliance with international obligations;
- agreed to a waiver of the 28-day rule so that the Measurement Standards Regulations 2019 can come into force on 20 May 2019.
