Thank you for your letter dated 14th March. Please find below New Zealand Cricket's feedback on the discussion documents on ticket reselling in New Zealand.

Price cap on resale tickets

- NZC generally **agrees** consumers are being misled.
- Suggest price capping at face value is fair.

Information disclosure requirements

- Agree more information could enable consumers to better understand how ticketing works
- Agree resale sites should be made to:
 - 1. disclose they are not official sellers; and
 - 2. disclose original price and seating locations.
- Suggest onus is on the ticket seller/retailer to lead information disclosure.

Ban on ticket-buying bots

- Agree bots can prevent consumers from having fair access to tickets.
- Agree enforcement would be difficult.

Joint industry-government actions

- Agree government involvement to better inform consumers and a stronger commitment to tackle scalping would be productive.
- Recommend more pointed and measured enforcement of marketing & promotion, specifically digital ads from resellers and scalpers which are inaccurate and dishonest.
