## World Radiocommunication Conference 2019: Approval to Attend and Sign the Final Acts

Portfolio Broadcasting, Communications and Digital Media

On 12 June 2019, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee

- agreed that New Zealand be represented at the World Radiocommunication Conference 2019 (the Conference), to be held in Sharm el-Sheikh, Egypt, from 28 October to 22 November 2019;
- agreed that the delegation be led by the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment, and include representatives from the New Zealand Defence Force and industry stakeholders;
- agreed that the New Zealand delegation seek to maintain an efficient, flexible and liberalised international radiocommunication regulation framework, which is consistent with:
  - 3.1 (the government's broader economic objectives;
  - 3.2 the interests of New Zealand consumers;
  - 3.3 World Trade Organisation agreements;
  - 3.4 New Zealand's telecommunications and broadcasting policy and regulatory regimes;
  - 3.5 the protection of existing radio-based services;
- 4 **noted** that the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment will seek necessary credentials from the Minister of Foreign Affairs, which will confirm the New Zealand delegation has the right to sign the Final Acts of the Conference;
- authorised the Minister of Broadcasting, Communications and Digital Media to authorise the New Zealand delegation to sign the Final Acts of the Conference on behalf of New Zealand;

**noted** that any treaty action within the Final Acts will be subject to New Zealand's domestic treaty process, which includes obtaining Cabinet approval.
