Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Kelvin Davis

Portfolio Tourism

On 4 June 2019, Cabinet:

- 1 **authorised** the absence of Hon Kelvin Davis from New Zealand, subject to leave from Parliament being secured, from 21 to 29 June 2019 to travel to China, to build on successful China-New Zealand Year of Tourism engagements with the Chinese Minister of Culture and Tourism;
- 2 **agreed** that he be accompanied by one member of staff;
- 3 **approved** the estimated expenditure of up to \$44,625 for the travel expenses of the Ministerial party, as a charge to Vote: Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive – Travel);
- 4 **noted** that he will be accompanied by two officials from each of the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment and Tourism New Zealand, whose costs will be met by their respective agencies;
- 5 **agreed** that in his absence:
 - 5.1 Hon Andrew Little act as Minister for Māori Crown Relations: Te Arawhiti and Minister of Corrections;
 - 5.2 Hon David Parker act as Minister of Tourism.
