Telecommunications Operators (Commerce Commission Costs) Levy Regulations 2019

Portfolio Broadcasting, Communications and Digital Media

On 17 September 2019, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- noted that on 1 May 2019, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee agreed to specify levies in connection with the performance of the Commerce Commission's functions and duties, and the exercise of its powers, under the Telecommunications Act 2001 [DEV-19-MIN-0091];
- 2 **noted** that the Telecommunications Operators (Commerce Commission Costs) Levy Regulations 2019 give effect to the decision referred to in paragraph 1 above;
- noted that section 13 of the Pelecommunications Act requires that the responsible Minister be satisfied that consultation has occurred before recommending the making of an Order in Council under section 11 and section 12 of the Act;
- 4 **noted** that the advice of the Minister of Broadcasting, Communications and Digital Media is that the statutory prerequisite referred to in paragraph 3 above has been met;
- noted that section 12 (5) of the Telecommunication Act states that the Minister must not recommend that regulations be made under this section unless the Minister is satisfied that the levy will not require a service provider, or a class of service providers, to pay a levy in respect of the same period under both this section and section 11 for, or in connection with:
 - 5.1 the performance of the Commission's functions and duties under Parts 2AA, 6, and 7; or
 - 5.2 the exercise of the Commission's powers under Parts 2AA, 6, and 7.
- 6 **noted** that the advice of the Minister of Broadcasting, Communications and Digital Media is that the statutory prerequisite referred to in paragraph 5 above has been met;
- authorised the submission to the Executive Council of the Telecommunications Operators (Commerce Commission Costs) Levy Regulations 2019 [PCO 21788/11.0];

8 note that the Telecommunications Operators (Commerce Commission Costs) Levy Regulations 2019 come into force on 31 October 2019.
