Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Willie Jackson

Portfolio **Employment**

On 16 September 2019, Cabinet:

- 1 **authorised** the absence of Hon Willie Jackson from New Zealand, from 29 September to 7 October 2019, to travel to:
 - 1.1 London, England to address a group of industry leaders and multinational organisations on youth employment initiatives in New Zealand and to undertake bilateral discussions;
 - 1.2 Edinburgh and Glasgow, Scotland to meet with officials to discuss employment and training, modern apprenticeships and youth employment;
- 2 **agreed** that he be accompanied by one staff member;
- 3 **approved** the estimated expenditure up to for the travel expenses of the Ministerial party, as a charge to Vote: Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive – Travel);
- 4 **noted** that he will be accompanied by his partner and child, and undertake four days of personal leave, with all associated costs met by him personally;
- 5 **agreed** that in his absence Hon Carmel Sepuloni act as Minister of Employment;
- 6 **noted** that the House is not sitting during his absence.
