#### **Other comments**

Could the acquisition of a DIN be made along with the first company annual return after implementation date rather than as a separate process. The annual return could be pre-populated with directors who already have a DIN and the application process completed for all those who don't. This would spread the processing and provide an ongoing portal for acquiring a DIN essentially making it compulsory for any company filing an annual return to have up to date information and DINs for all its directors.
